#### PROGRAM DESCRIPTION

The MBTI is the most widely used and accepted Personality Type instrument in the world. The purpose for its use can range from improvement of individual skills and abilities to organizational development. It is used effectively in areas such as communication, human dynamics, teamwork, leadership, and improving overall organizational strength and capacity.

In the first part of the program Scott Savage will describe how he uses the MBTI in his work as a recognized provider of individual and team development, and conflict management solutions in both private and public sectors.

In the second part of the program Scott will take us through the Peer learning Process developed by the Edward Lowe Foundation which he uses monthly with CEO's and Presidents of small high growth companies in Madison, Wisconsin. He will then engage the group in the process for the balance of the meeting.

This will be a highly experiential program and the takeaways will be the use of a powerful model for enhancing communication and a rich and structured group process experience. These can be applied in participants' work and lives.
